Summary

Responsible for working with existing software systems to improve functionality and management reporting in addition to assisting with development of new software systems and web resources.

Key Responsibilities

Investigate and resolve any problems or issues with existing software systems, liaising with users and third party providers where necessary. Also to investigate and monitor service and performance related issues.

Design and implement a range of management reports which integrate with existing software to be delivered on a regular basis to key people in the business.

Maintenance and improvement of PDA applications authored with Pocket PC Creations to ensure smooth operation and reliable data capture and storage.

Work with third parties who are developing software on behalf of OHS Ltd to integrate new systems into the company.

Produce data export queries and routines to export data to third party or client systems in various formats such as CSV or Excel Spreadsheet.

Assist with general technical support in the office.

Ensure that the role is carried out in accordance with all agreed policies, procedures, legislation and guidance.

Observe and work to OHS Ltd coding standards and methodology.

Adhere to the OHS Ltd Integrated Management System which sets out the procedures which employees are required to follow.

Support the development of a new web-enabled system to manage the entire business workflow for OHS.
