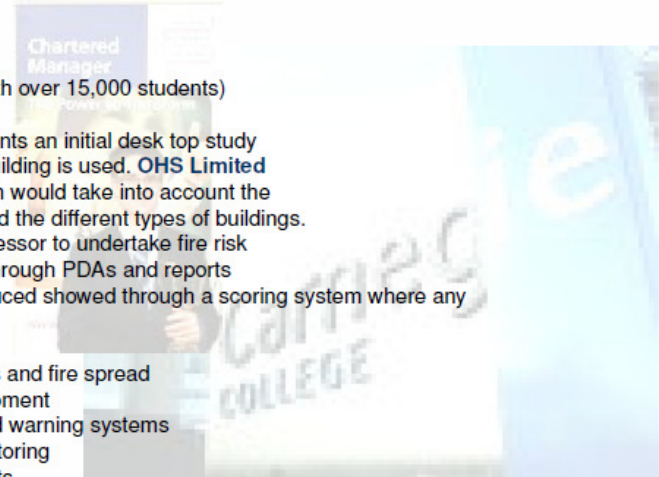
Overview: OHS Limited was approached by Carnegie College to undertake Fire Risk Assessments to all of their premises. A large college campus with over 15,000 students and multiple buildings they recognised that OHS Limited could provide a high standard of service which represented value for money.

Sector: Higher Education

Location: Dunfermline, Scotland (Multiple education buildings with over 15,000 students)

The OHS Role: In order to fully understand the client's requirements an initial desk top study was undertaken to assess the types of buildings and how each building is used. OHS Limited recognised that the client needed risk assessments in place which would take into account the thousands of members of the public passing through each day and the different types of buildings. OHS Limited deployed an experienced and qualified fire risk assessor to undertake fire risk assessments to all of the campus buildings. Data was collected through PDAs and reports were formulated through our Tracker database. The reports produced showed through a scoring system where any improvements were required and taken into account:

- Sources of ignition
- Sources of fuel
- People at risk
- Means of escape
- Fire emergency plan and training
- Structural features and fire spread
- Fire fighting equipment
- Fire detection and warning systems
- Review and monitoring
- General comments



Through the fire risk assessments OHS identified that the assessments which were in place were not being monitored and that a standard check protocol needed to be implemented. OHS worked with the college to set up an effective monitoring regime.
