An area where **OHS** are increasing their influence is that of Occupational Hygiene Management in areas not immediately associated with this service. This involves sectors such as social housing developments and universities and colleges, especially those with campuses and designated areas of student accommodation.

The word occupational may not readily be thought of as relevant to where individuals live but these areas have need of employees in a variety of varied functions including working in diverse areas such as grounds and gardens, catering, car parks, cleaning, administration etc. and employers need to safeguard the health and safety of all these employees.

The Occupational Hygiene disciplines covered in the above include:-
Cleaning - COSHH
Maintenance/Estates - Vibration, noise and COSHH
Car parks - DEEE (diesel fumes)/COSHH
Admin - Indoor Air Quality/Sick Building Syndrome/COSHH

OHS work very closely on health and safety management with the newly expanded Leeds College. The college has in 2009 merged Leeds College of Technology, Leeds Thomas Danby, Keighley College and Park Lane College Leeds to form one of the largest and most influential colleges in the country with over 60,000 students and an annual turnover of £70m

OHS operate a rigorous programme of surveying and auditing for the college and this is backed up by first class training of staff and by diligent reporting and data collation.
